Three Primary Funding Types

- State Core Contract
 - Appropriation to State Library; from GenFund,
 RIT, DEQ, FWP, DNRC, MDT & Univ. System
- Supplemental Funding for Core Services
 - From Federal, State & private partners
- Projects

Purpose of Core Funding

Supports Primary Data Services

- Data & Info Capture & review/validation
- Data integration and management
- Analysis and products: ranking, field guides
- Information dissemination & services
- Expertise & Consultation

Cost of Core Services

Staffing

- Scientists with expertise in major species groups and ecosystem types
- IT specialists with expertise in biological data management, GIS & web services
- Data processing and data request support
- Management and admin services

Operations

- Supplies, equipment, travel, etc.

Core Funding Challenge

NHP Core Costs: \$633,000 - \$668,000

Current Core Contract: \$303,000

Other Funding for

Core Services (approx): \$125,000

Remaining need: \$205,000 - \$240,000

Results of inadequate core funding

- Must rely on projects for major part of core staff's salaries.
- Core staff must spend significant time fundraising, as well as working on and managing projects; prevents completion of core work & produces high stress-load.
- Inadequate or unreliable staffing for critical functions like data processing, web services.


Strategies for full core funding

 Increase appropriation for State Core Contract

 Increase funding from Federal agencies and others that rely on NHP services

Annual MSL Contract Funding



Current MSL Contract: \$303,000

Proposed Goal: Additional \$150,000

Notes:

- o \$10,000 retained by MSL for agency expenses
- o Figures represent 41% of all sources to overall NRIS funding of \$742,000
- Reflects \$18,750 reduction from funding level in FY02-03 biennium.

Options for Increasing State Appropriation

Increase agency contributions

Increase General Fund contribution

Increase RIT Fund contribution

Strategy for Core Contract Increase

Goal: \$150,000 increase, totaling \$453,000

Potential Strategies:

- Maintain RIT at current level of \$160,000
- Maintain University obligation at \$18,000 (seek future increases directly through UM)
- Divide \$150,000 increase between:
 - General Fund: currently @ \$28,000
 - Four agencies: currently totaling \$97,000

One Scenario...

If increase came half from the GF and the other half divided equally among the agencies, the result would be:

GF: Increase from \$28,000 to \$103,000

<u>Agencies</u>: Incr. from \$97,000 to \$172,000 resulting in <u>equal contributions of \$43,000</u>

Basis for Agency Contributions

- All "Source Agencies" rely heavily on NHP
- 2005 web survey: 80-100% of responding staff from each agency rated two or more NHP services as "Very Useful" or "Essential"
- Usage patterns vary: requests, web, consultation
- Source agency use differs more in form than quantity

Result of Proposed Increases

New Current Core Contract: \$453,000

New Supplementary Funding: \$215,000

Total NHP Core Funding: \$668,000

Next Steps

 Take forward a recommendation from NHP Partners Committee...

 Work with NRIS Advisory Committee to integrate into overall NRIS budget request.

 Work with Federal agencies and others to increase supplemental core by \$90,000.

Interim Strategies for FY07


Focus on Priority "Core Data Projects"
