## **BENEFIT/OUTCOME SUMMARY BY PROGRAM**

## **Program 1: TWO MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS**

#### Narrative:

Two membership meetings will be held in FY 2008-2009 one in the fall and one in the spring. All librarians and public library trustees within the Federation are encouraged to attend and participate. It is beneficial that the Montana State Library staff and State Commissioners participate in the meetings.

### The coordinator will:

- -Arrange meetings with the host libraries
- -Create and distribute appropriate notices and documents for the meetings
- -Attend at least 3 State Library Commissioners meetings

Public libraries will receive mileage money for both meetings as determined by approved travel zones.

- -Libraries traveling less sthan 100 miles round trip will receive no reimbursement.
- -Libraries traveling between 100-200 miles round trip will receive \$50
- -Libraries traveling between 200-300 miles round trip will receive \$75
- -Libraries traveling more than 300 miles round trip will receive \$100

## These meetings will:

- -Conduct the business of the federation, including election of officers, in accourance with its by-laws
- -Create the POS for the following year in a timely manner with membership participation.
- -Allow networking among colleagues by sharing "joys and concerns" of each library attending
- -Provide an opportunity for continuing education

### Benefit/Outcome:

Thirteen Public Libraries received mileage stipends for two meetings during 2008-2009. Eleven Public Libraries and one Special Library attended the two Federation meetings. Officer's were elected, a plan of service for 2009-2010 was prepared during the spring meeting. Joys and concerns were shared from the library directors or the trustees. Attendees had the opportunity to receive 1.5 CE's for programs that were presented. The fall meeting presentation was on Censhorship and library policies and the spring was on Montana Law Library and the resources each library can use to help patrons. CE is available for all attendees if they wish to collect it.

## **Program 2: TRAINING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

#### Narrative:

Library staff will attend training and/or professional opportunities at local, state and national levels. Includes but is not limited to workshops, on-line courses, conferences and academic classes. Registration, mileage, lodging, meals and maaterials may be included in the costs.

Training and Professional Development is very important to ensure library efficiency, communication among library workers, trustees, patrons and State Library Employees and to provide knowledge and technical skills needed to provide excellent service to users.

The following trainings were attended with the assistance of Federation Money.

**Public Library Association** 

ASLD/PLD Retreat provided by MLA

Offline for technical support provided by MLA

MLA Conference

Montana Legislative Day is important to the funding of public libraries. Some of the federation libraries used these funds to help them attend the day so they could talk with their Legislators concerning libraries in their communities and let them know what libraries can do for the citizens of Montana.

## **Program 3: TECHNOLOGY**

#### Narrative:

Libraries need to meet the minimal technology requirments to be able to participate in a shared catalog, interlibrary loan, etc. Each library will determine how to best address their technology needs.

Purchases may include, but are not limited to:

- -Computer hardware, software and upgrades, firewall security
- -Printers, scanners
- -Membership costs for OCLC, Montana Shared Catalog, Virtual Reference
- -Database costs for Info Trac, tec.
- -Outreach and public relations costs promoting access to collections and library services (Example of costs outside the scope of this program include, but are not limited to: e-books, furniture, barcodes and other supplies)

### Benefit/Outcome:

Technology money was used to enhance several services in libraries. Some libraries updated patron computers to improve the quality of access patrons have. Staff computers were upgraded to allow staff more reliable access to information that patrons are looking for. One library purchased a new server and donated the old server to a fellow Federation Library for a backup to their server. Others purchased software to provide network security or stand alone circulation systems. All of the above help to provide reliable access to the citizens of Montana.

## **Program 4: EXPANDING AND SHARING COLLECTIONS**

### Narrative:

Libraries may purchase and share collection materials in accordance with the Tamarack Federation Collection Policy, including creating Book Club kits. To encourage and assist in sharing collections, libraries may choose to apply funds to courier and /or postage costs.

Internet access provides individuals with many sources of information they are looking for but it is aparent through library use statitics in the Tamarack Federation that physical materials are very important to the users.

The Patner's program moves many thousand materials around the state and libraries are able to participate in this program through the use of Federation Funds to pay for the postage, bus, or courier services that help in facilitating the movement of the materials to expand collections quick and seamlessly without needing more shelf space to house those collections. Other libraries are expanding their physical collection through the purchase of materials which are housed by the purchasing library. Online resources are also a way to expand collections. Federation money allowed some libraries to participate in the state purchase of Heritage Quest a genealogy resource.

## **Program 5: PLANNING FOR BUILDING IMPROVEMENT**

#### Narrative:

Libraries may use funds to support the costs of PLANNING for the best use of space directly related to federation-wide activities. Costs may include, but are not limited to:

- -Consultant fees and travel
- -Design models
- -Wireless feasibility studies
- -Cost analysis reviews for adding a courier access area

#### Benefit/Outcome:

Polson was able to hire a consultant to help in the planning and preparation of a renovation project. Without these funds it would be difficult to budget funds to hire consultants for these projects.

## **Program 6: MULTI-TYPE LIBRARIES**

### Narrative:

Non-public libraries (special, academic, school) may receive mileage money to attend the federation membership meetings. These libraries must request the money through the Federation Coordinator. Money will be distributed on a first come first served basis with mileage determined accourding to approved travel zones.

### Benefit/Outcome:

Some multi-type libraries participate in the Federation meetings but do not apply for mileage because their mileage. This money was used to purchase book chat bag books that are circulated through the Missoula Public Library for book groups. The kits come with books and a guide for the book discussion. Positive and negative book reviews are included so the discussion leader can use the resosurces without doing any outside research on their own. These bags are very popular with state libraries as well as out of state. Tamarack libraries are encouraged to send suggested titles to Molly at MPL.
