Support challenges identified by MSC staff related to supporting school libraries

Training and general support challenges:

- Higher staff turnover leads to additional time handling support requests and requires more continual training
- More likelihood of non-dedicated staff
- School librarians are generally harder to connect with for support related issues and to arrange training
- Overall, more time is needed to train and guide school librarians with the aspects of a
 sophisticated library management system. These aspects include transferring library
 holding records, identifying and importing bibliographic records, how to perform
 advanced searches, how to perform copy cataloging, setting system properties,
 uninstalling/installing software clients and running successful usage reports.

Specific system administration challenges:

- Additional system support required to perform system annual student roll-ups
- Additional system support required in setting up, maintaining and scheduling school specific reports for statistics, overdue notices/lists by grade or teacher and summer reports run for suspending and unsuspending user records
- Additional system support required in gathering, configuring and entering school closure dates for end-of-school year due dates and then removing them at the beginning of the school year
