RE: Renewal Options for Statewide Database Suite and HomeworkMT Live Tutoring Service

About the Statewide Database and Online Services Suite

The Montana State Library has been able to cover the entire cost of the FY12-13 contracts that provide statewide databases and online services to Montana citizens. This is made possible through an allocation from the 2011 Montana Legislature and support from the Governor's budget office and the efforts of the State Librarian, the State Library Commission, and the Montana Library Association. The current legislative allocation is \$634,994 for the FY12-13 biennium, or \$317,497 per fiscal year.

EBSCO is the provider of the statewide databases for the contract period. The statewide databases contract with EBSCO for FY12-13 has allowed for unlimited access to the databases in the EBSCO Elite package, as well as 7 separate EBSCO databases (listed in Appendix A - Part I).

Tutor.com is the site behind HomeworkMT, a statewide service that includes online resources and live tutors for K-12 and college students and career resources for adults (detailed in Appendix A - Part II).

Database usage statistics from the beginning of the contract period (September 1, 2011) through February 2013 are listed in Appendix B.

Any Montana library that is listed in the Montana Library Directory has access to these statewide databases and services through August 31, 2013. Funding sources for statewide subscription databases beyond August 2013 are dependent on this year's legislative session.

A Note Regarding the Current Budget Request

Decision Package 102, which is a Montana State Library budget request that would allow for a \$26,000 inflationary increase for statewide databases and online services costs, passed unanimously before the House Appropriations Committee and will be considered by the Senate Finance and Claims Committee on March 6. This request is part of the overall House Bill 2 funding package, the outcome of which will not be known until the session concludes.

EBSCO: Proposed Contract Renewal Pricing

MSL's statewide databases contract with EBSCO for FY12-13 allowed for unlimited access to the databases listed in Appendix A at a total cost of \$249,260 per year.

EBSCO has proposed an increase of 2.5% (\$6,232) for FY14, bringing the total cost to \$255,492. MSL is currently in negotiations with EBSCO to hold to this single increase for a two year contract renewal, should this contract be renewed.

Tutor: Proposed Contract Renewal Pricing Options

MSL's current contract with Tutor for FY12-13 allowed for unlimited statewide live homework help sessions, plus access to the Adult Education & Career Center, at a total cost of \$68,237 per year. The proposed pricing options available for a renewed statewide contract represent either a cost increase in order to sustain existing live tutor services, or no cost increase but reduced live tutor services.

Tutor has presented MSL with three pricing options for FY14 contract renewal:

A.	No increase in usage – up to 7,800 sessions, which is the projected number of sessions completed during the past contract year. Any unused sessions can roll over to the next year's contract.	\$68,237 per year
В.	Increase number of sessions to accommodate projected 9% increase in usage (up to 8,502 sessions, at an additional expense of \$4,030). Any unused sessions can roll over to the next year's contract.	\$72,267 per year
C.	Unlimited number of sessions, but exclusive to school libraries (at an additional expense of \$15,763).	\$84,000 per year
