

 When I scan this item, I get a weird pop-up message. What do I do?




MSC COST-SHARE FORMULA

- Based on stats directly from the system:
 - title count (30%)
 - circulation count (10%)
 - patron count (30%)
- Remaining 30% divided equally among libraries.
- Cost breaks are applied based on criteria found in <u>Cost Share</u> <u>Formula in the Montana Shared</u> <u>Catalog</u>

Title/Item Clean-Up

Items are missing from the shelves

Scenario: you're doing inventory



System: marks the items you didn't scan missing







Missing item records need to be resolved



System: sends you a reminder to deal with them



You decide: replace the item or remove the record?

Replace

- Purchase a replacement copy
- Add the replacement copy to the correct record.
- Remove the missing copy from system (discard or delete).



Remove the record

- Review the instructions for Discarding vs Deleting Item Records in WorkFlows.
- Discard or delete the record as appropriate.

Items are lost after checkout

Scenario: a patron doesn't tell you they've lost an item



System: assumes the item is lost after a designated amount of time

Checked out to account

Assumed Lost

- Inactive checkout (shadowed)
- Account billed

Lost item record removed from account

- Bill stays
- Note added

Lost item records need to be resolved

Scenario: you're blissfully ignorant about the lost item

System: assumes the lost item record needs to be dealt with after a designated amount of time

Checked out to account

Assumed Lost

- Inactive checkout (shadowed)
- Account billed
- Patron notified

Lost item record removed from account


- Bill stays
- Note added

Lost item records need to be resolved

Scenario: you're still blissfully ignorant about the lost item



System: sends you a reminder to deal with lost items



You decide: replace the item or remove the record?

Replace

- Purchase a replacement copy
- Add the replacement copy to the correct record.
- Remove the lost copy from system (discard or delete).



Remove the record

- Review the instructions for Discarding vs Deleting Item Records in WorkFlows.
- Discard or delete the record as appropriate.

The system can also remind you about...

- Items still being processed
- Items still in transit
- Items still cataloged as "new"
- Items that patrons claimed to have returned
- Items waiting to be replaced
- Items about to be discarded from the system
- And more just ask!







Items still cataloged as "new"




Patron Account Clean-Up

Question from Chat

- When an item is Assumed Lost and our library is the only one that has a copy of that item, the record becomes unfindable via title or ISBN search. They are only findable via the item number or title control number. Why is this?
 - I looked up to confirm why the item is unable to be located via a title or author browse search and that is because the home location of LOST is shadowed. When more than one library exists on the record, depending on what you have selected for the 'in this library' dropdown, the item will still come up, but when only your copy exists on the record, the whole thing becomes shadowed so only an exact search via the item id or title control number will bring up the item.
- Would it be possible to set it up so that Assumed Lost items aren't shadowed, both to prevent findability issues and to allow patrons to continue placing holds?
 - Unfortunately no, that is a system default that we are unable to change.




