 - Limited funding for state government publications digitization


Digital Opportunities Capacity Grant Application

- Montana submitted it's application on May 28, 2024
- Secondary funding priorities requested in the application include:
 - Funding to extend Wi-Fi upgrades to any libraries not previously upgraded
 - Broadband study refresh
 - LinkedIn Learning access at all public and tribal college libraries
 - Computer replacements for all staff and public access computers at public and tribal college libraries
 - Continued hot spot funding at a reduced capacity
 - Network health monitoring service for all public and tribal college libraries
- Montana will be notified about the status of their application by August 28, 2024

Lifelong Learning Trunk Survey

MSL Lifelong Learning is working to determine how to manage the storage needs of the trunk program. After the flood and relocation to a smaller building the MSL has less storage space.

We have determined that if the trunks are out and circulating this would not have a significant impact to the program, but this also means the libraries would need to take on more management of the trunks. Many suggestions have been made for new, updated trunks, and more copies of the bat trunk. We are also looking into making them smaller and easier to lift, stack, move and ship which should make management easier than it has been with previous trunks.


Before taking the next steps to order materials to make these updates we need to know what you want, and what your limitations are when it comes to storage, scheduling and maintenance of the trunk program.

Remembering Lisa



Having worked in both special and public libraries, Lisa understood and appreciated how libraries serve people in all aspects of their lives and livelihoods. As an attorney, she shared unparalleled legal knowledge with libraries and the patrons she served. Lisa worked tirelessly to promote the work of libraries. For many, Lisa is synonymous with the Sheila Cates Scholarship, awarded annually by the Montana Library Association in honor of the State Library's own Sheila Cates, who also died of cancer. It was my honor to know Lisa as both my colleague and my friend.


