## RESOLUTION 13-05 RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION ON THE CREATION OF THE RONAN LIBRARY DISTRICT

- WHEREAS, the Board of Lake County Commissioners held a public hearing on February 6, 2013 at the Lake County Courthouse, and following public hearing and comment, has determined a proposal to create the Ronan Library district merits presentation to the voters of Lake County who reside within the proposed library district boundaries; and
- WHEREAS, Sections 22-1-703 and 15-10-420, MCA, authorize the Board of Lake County Commissioners, following consideration of a library district proposal, to request of the voters an increase in mill levies; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed boundaries of the Ronan Library District are identical to those of Lake County School District No. 30 (30-1 and 30-2); and
- whereas, the proposal contemplates holding a mill levy election imposing a permanent maximum mill levy of 27 mills upon property owners in the proposed library district, which would amount to \$39.77 per year for a property with a market value of \$100,000 and \$79.54 per year for a property with a market value of \$200,000 (based upon 2011 tax year values); and
- WHEREAS, the proposed number of members serving on the Ronan Library District Board of Trustees is seven; and
- WHEREAS, the Ronan Library District will make all reasonable efforts to provide services to, and work cooperatively with, all non-district public libraries in Lake County.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be placed before the voters of Lake County School District No. 30 an election on a permanent mill levy for the creation of the Ronan Library District and it is requested of the Lake County Election Administrator that said election is conducted by mail ballot pursuant to Title 13, chapter 19, MCA, and held on May 7, 2013.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the boundaries of the proposed district shall be identical to those of Lake County School District No. 30 (30-1 and 30-2), the maximum mill levy for the proposed district shall be 27 mills, and there shall be seven members on the proposed district's board of trustees.
