STILLWATER COUNTY LIBRARY PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project involves the acquisition and alteration of an existing building for the relocation of the county library. The renovated 3500 square foot facility will quadruple the space available in the current facility allowing for a children's area, a conference/meeting room, a book drop, and additional stack area. The building will include handicapped access not only to the building but also to the restrooms, stack area, and work areas.

This construction project relates to Goal #1 of Chapter 9: "FOR SPECIAL ATTENTION - Special Users"; and to Goals #1 & #2 of Chapter 4: "LIBRARY AS COMMUNITY CENTER"; of Montana's updated long range plan: Partners in Progress.
