### **FUNDING**

The money to address the training needs of the library staff will be paid out of the annual funds the library receives from the Golden Plains Library Federation specifically earmarked for training. The money to pay for the library's Heritage Quest and Overdrive databases comes from the library's materials budget. The money to pay for the library's OCLC costs comes from the library's line item for contract services in the annual budget. The costs for the purchase of new computers/technology/Montana Shared Catalog comes from money received as a bequest last fiscal year which was added to the library's depreciation fund. That portion of the phone bill used to cover Internet services comes from the e-rate money. Finally, the rest of the telecommunication costs for telephone service comes from the library budget.
