OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF POWDER RIVER COUNTY, HELD AT THE COURTHOUSE IN BROADUS, MONTANA, Oct. 7, 8, 9, 1963

Oct. 7, 1963

The Board of County Commissioners of Powder River County, Montana, met on the above date in regular session with members Delbert Hanson, Leslie T. Wilson and Frank N. Carter in attendance. Minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved. The monthly cash report of County Treasurer, Ann Carroll, was approved. ~~At 10:00 o'clock A. M. as per advertised notice, a public hearing was held, and a resolution to establish a County Free Library at Broadus, Montana, was unanimously adopted by the board, as no taxpayers appeared to protest the adoption of said resolution.~~ The appointment of Nina Schmalz as Deputy Clerk of the District Court was approved by the board. Charles A. Lynch, Director Montana Aeronautics Commission and Ed Granger, Airport Engineer met with the board to discuss obtaining land for an airport site.
