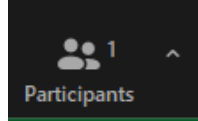


Zooming like a pro!

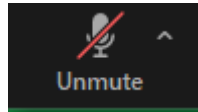
- Rename Yourself

- If you do not have a microphone, you can call in on a phone.



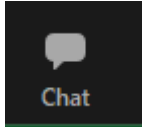
- Video

- We love seeing your smiling faces, but if you prefer to, you can turn video off by clicking “Stop Video” in the lower left-hand corner of the Zoom screen.



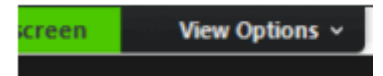
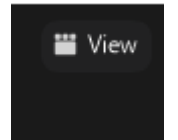
- Chat

- Click the “Chat” icon to add your comments or questions.



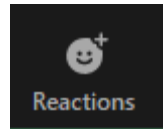
- View Options

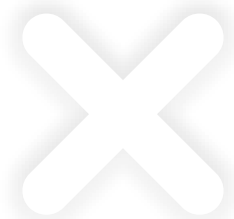
- Choose how you want to see the speaker and other participants. Choose gallery for the Brady Bunch effect.

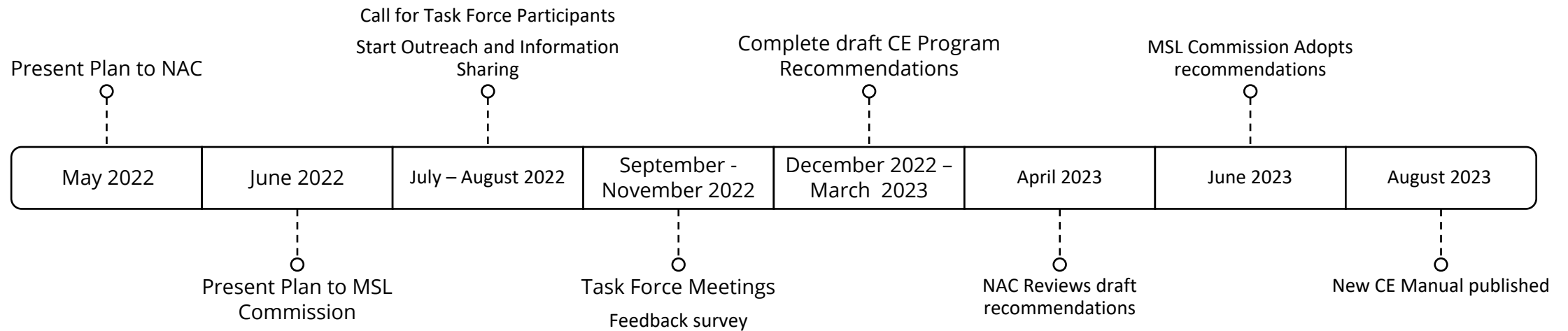

Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM)

10.102

TRUSTEES

NEW Rule I

The board receives at least three hours of continuing education each year

PERSONNEL

NEW RULE III

The Director is or will be certified by the Montana State Library within the required timeframe mandated by the certification program adopted by the Montana State Library Commission.

Directors of libraries that serve over 25,000 people have a Master of Library Science or equivalent degree

The board adopts a sufficient budget for continuing education

Staff have the tools and training they need to perform their work

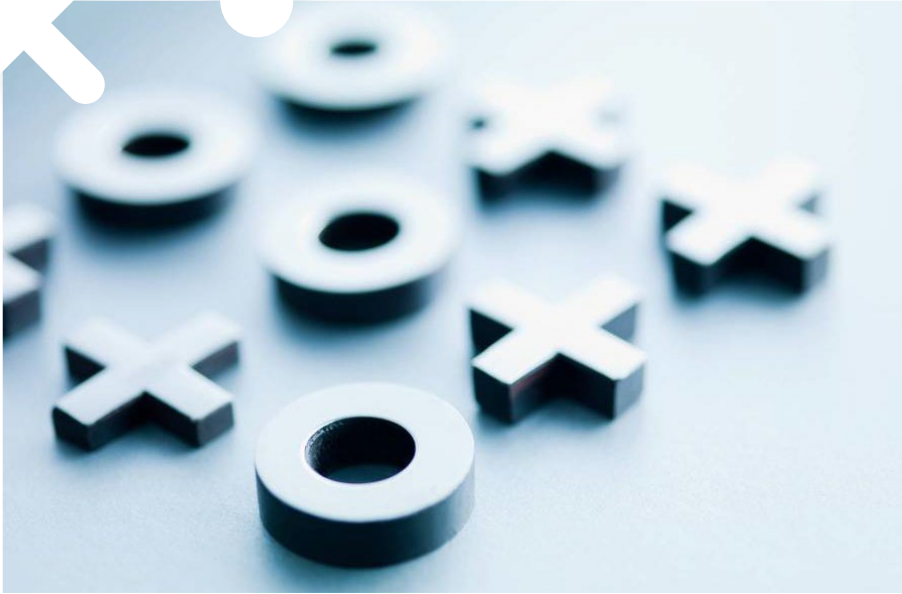
Standards Implementation Timeline
