Re: Collection Management Honor Roll 2000

Date: March 27, 2001

The four criteria for the Commission's Collection Management Honor Roll are:

- 1) Library has an approved Collection Management Policy on file at MSL;
- 2) Library's Policy has been appropriately updated and is current;
- 3) Over 50% of the library's titles are entered on the OCLC database;
- 4) Library has been actively updating the OCLC/WLN database for at least the past three years.

Preparation of the 2000 Honor Roll began in November with a mailing to all libraries having collection management policies on file at MSL giving the status of that policy (current, approved, revision needed, etc.). Several notices were also placed on wired-mt announcing the Honor Roll and its criteria, and offering assistance/guidelines to libraries interested in writing a new policy or revising an existing policy.

During the last four months, librarians have been sending policy updates or revisions in order to meet the first two requirements listed above. Darlene reviewed each policy that was received. Following this review, comments were sent to the libraries in electronic format.

In late March, a list of libraries having current and approved policies was sent to OCLC requesting holdings data for these libraries. From the information OCLC compiled, we determine which libraries met the final two criteria needed to make the Honor Roll. One dilemma posed by the OCLC data was that some school districts require a single collection management policy for the entire district, but only the high school submits holdings records to OCLC. In these cases, we are recommending that the Honor Roll listing be for the high school library and not the entire district.

Attached is the list of libraries we recommend for the 2000 Honor Roll. This includes nine academic libraries, thirty-two public libraries, six school libraries and one special library, for a total of forty-eight libraries (compared to forty-two libraries in 1999). Of these, ten are libraries that were not on the Honor Roll last year. The Honor Roll will be announced during the MLA Conference awards luncheon on April 28th in Kalispell.
