After 34 years at Miles Community College, Larry Torstenbo retired in May 2004. Larry advocated for the building of this library. Both Larry and those responsible for the plans can be commended for their foresight. We were able to physically rearrange the facilities in July and August, 2004, making the library appear much larger and allowing for better unobtrusive observation of the facilities and needs of our users. This was the perfect opportunity to significantly weeding the collection.

By teaching the use of the databases, catalog, and WebPages (Information Literacy Presentations) and providing space, materials, 24/7 access, and enough staff, I think these numbers show significant use of the library and its resources.
