Connecting Shared Catalogs Projects:

Montana/OCLC NCIP and Home Delivery Pilot

The NCIP piece of this pilot tests the ability of Montana Shared Catalog libraries which do not currently share user and circulation privileges to pass circulation information to each other, using the NISO Circulation Interchange Protocol (NCIP). The outcome is the ability for a library user from Library A to discover, request and receive material from Library B. OCLC provides centralized NCIP authentication between these libraries.

The Home Delivery piece of the pilot tests the option of home delivery to the user. OCLC has provided mailing supplies and metering machines to the libraries and is covering the cost of delivery to the user's home, if the user chooses this option.

The pilot was launched in May, following six months of preparation between OCLC, SirsiDynix (the ILS vendor involved in this pilot) and MSL staff.
