Goal One – Content - *Montana State Library (MSL) acquires and manages relevant quality content that meets the needs of Montana library partners and patrons.*

- Added three new libraries to MontanaLibrary2Go
- Continued procurement processes for an integrated discovery system/open URL resolver and for a new suite of statewide databases working with evaluation committees and the Network Advisory Council

Goal Two—Access – *MSL provides libraries, agencies, and its partners and patrons with convenient, high quality, and cost-effective access to library content and services.*

- Initiated renewal process for the OCLC Group Services contract for FY2011
- Added the OCLC Digital Archive subscription to the contract to provide long term access to digital materials submitted to the Montana Memory Project
