Re: On-call Policy status

In June, staff presented a proposed update to the State Library on-call policy which was drafted, in part, to ensure that the Library fairly compensates Montana Shared Catalog (MSC) staff who may be on-call during open library hours which include evening and longer weekend hours. After considering the impact of moving the MSC system to a cloud-based system hosted by the vendor, SirsiDynix, staff believes that it may no longer be necessary to provide on-call. MSC staff has requested time to discuss this need with the MSC membership at the October membership meeting.

Staff will bring a revised on-call policy to the Commission at their October meeting which will reflect the input from the MSC membership and staff. No action is requested on the policy at this time.
