Core Services Committees

Network

- Creates an overarching vision with goals and objectives for a core service that is tied to meeting the overall goal of the Montana Library Network.
- Sets, monitors, and evaluates outcome/impact statements defined by the core services committees across all projects within that core service.
- Defines what projects/programs are within a core service.
- Uses the evaluation framework for a particular project/program along with knowledge of other projects and core services to identify barriers and potential solutions and to evaluate whether the project is meeting the desired outcomes of the overarching core service.
- Makes recommendations to the NAC on what to fund, where to allocate staff time for core services work, and what barriers should be addressed.
