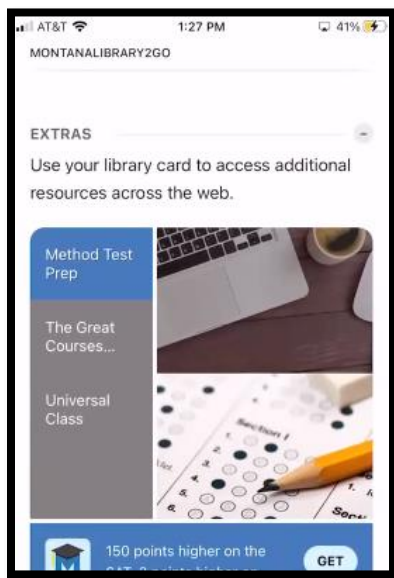


## Introduction to Libby Extras

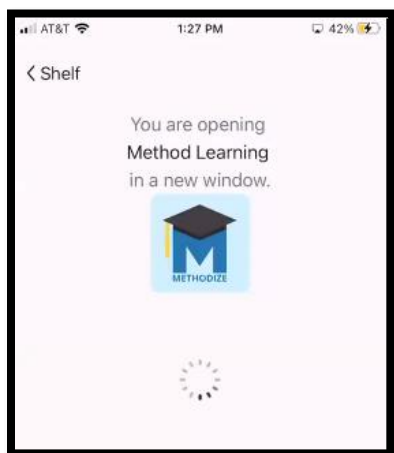
MontanaLibrary2Go has added three new resources to the Libby platform for 2022:

- Method Test Prep
- The Great Courses
- Universal Class

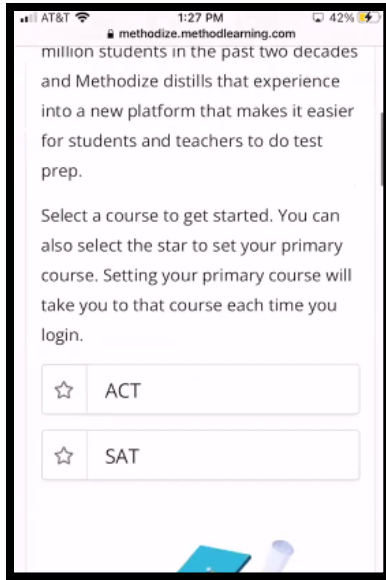
You can find these resources by opening the Libby app and scrolling down to the “Extras” box on the home screen.



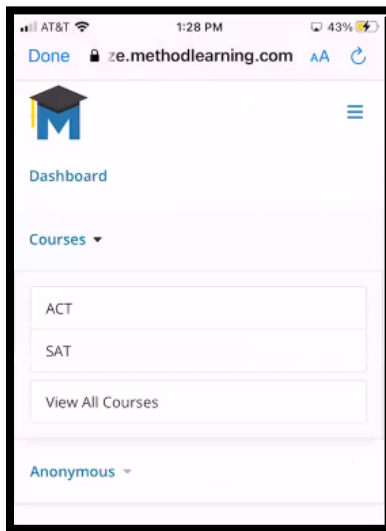
First, we will look at Method Test Prep. Tap on the Method Test Prep button and tap “Get” in the lower right corner of the “Extras” box. You will be offered a 7-day pass.



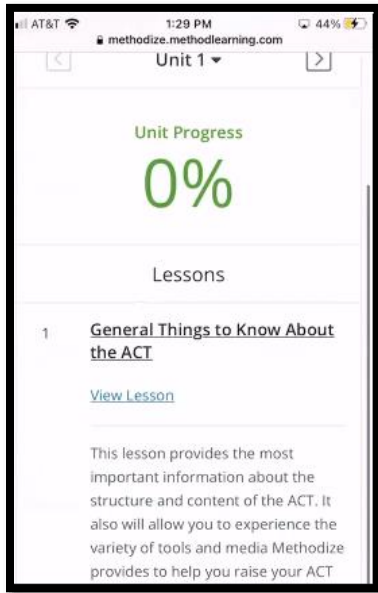
This will open Method Learning in a new browser window outside the Libby app.



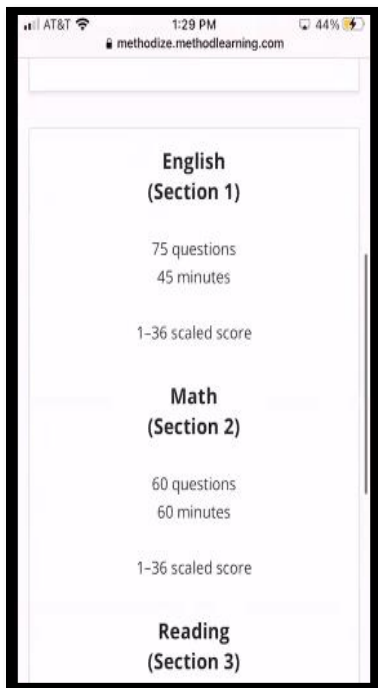
Method offers test preparation materials for both the ACT and the SAT exams.



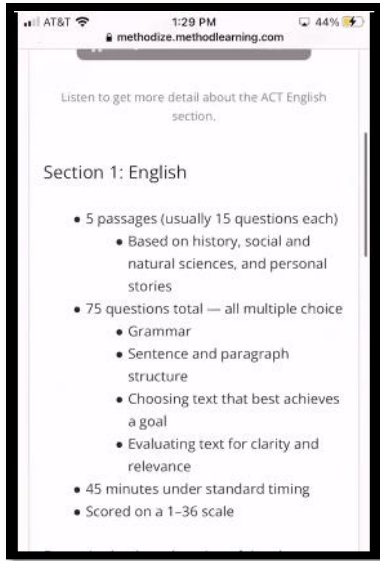
Tap the “M” mortarboard icon to view your courses and account information.



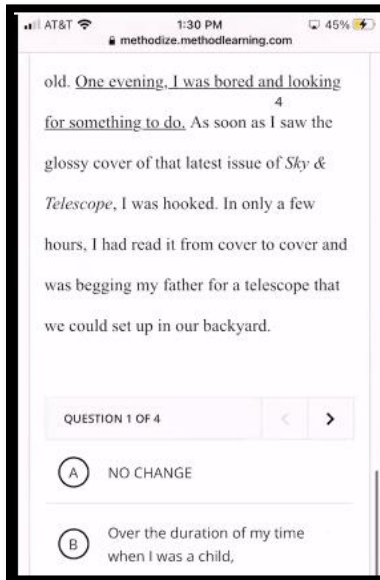
Within each exam course you can view your progress and the course outline.



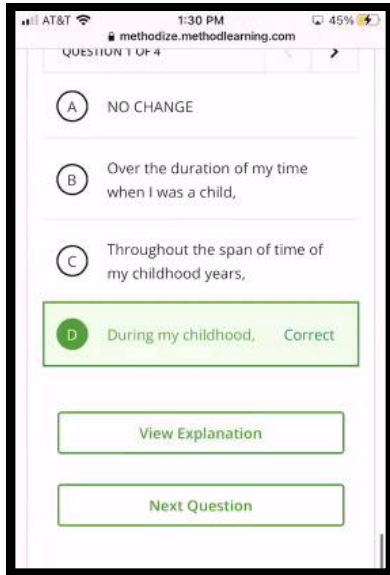
The outline will break down the components within each section.



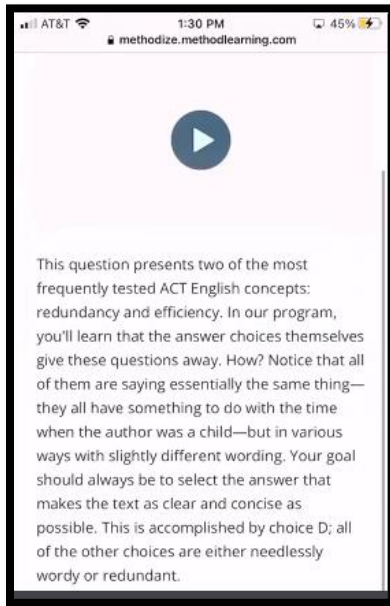
Each section is broken down into what content you can expect to find in the exam.



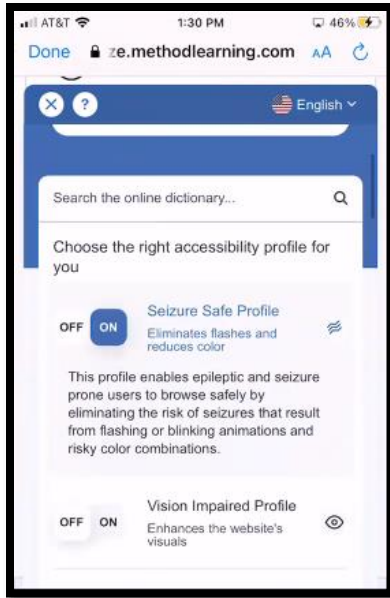
You can practice each of these sections separately outside of the full practice exam.



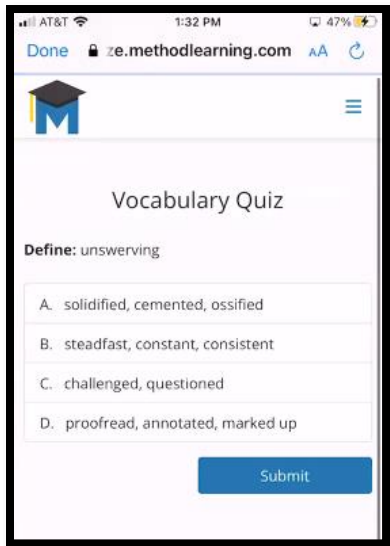
Each practice question also provides an explanation for the correct answer.



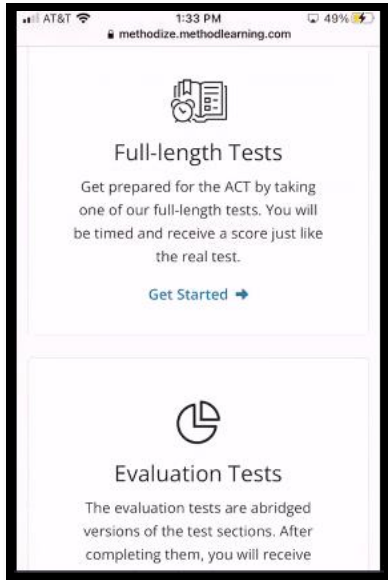
Here is a sample explanation for an ACT English practice question.



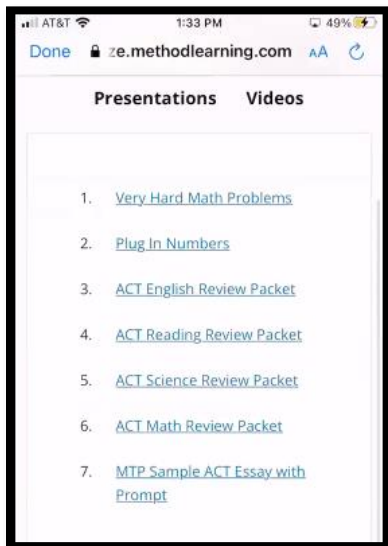
You can find several accessibility options to customize your app interface by tapping on the person icon in the lower right corner of the screen.



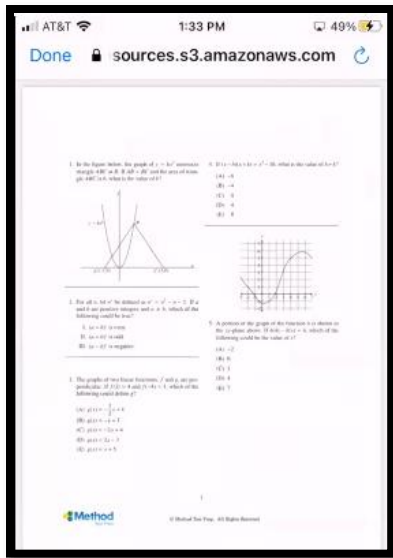
In addition to the ACT and SAT practice exams, there is a vocabulary quiz to help you master words commonly found on the exams.



The full-length practice exams offer an opportunity to rehearse taking the test in real time, with a timer and a score.



Additional resources, found under “Resources” on each exam’s home page, help you focus on preparing in specific areas.

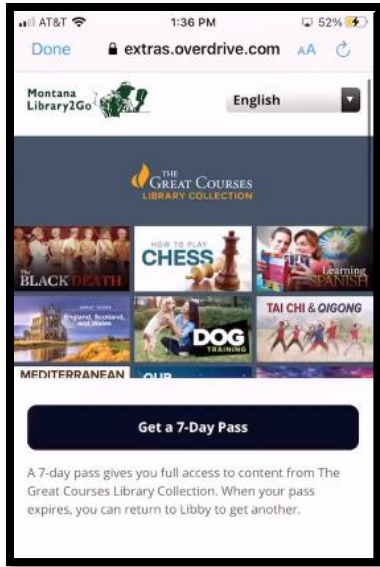


Review packets, found under “Resources,” are PDF bundles that will open in a separate window and that can be downloaded.

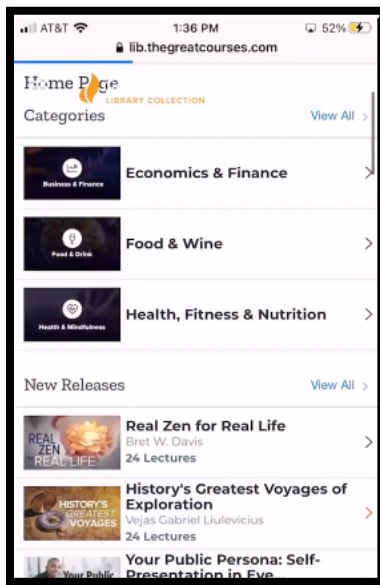


The next resource we are going to look at is The Great Courses.

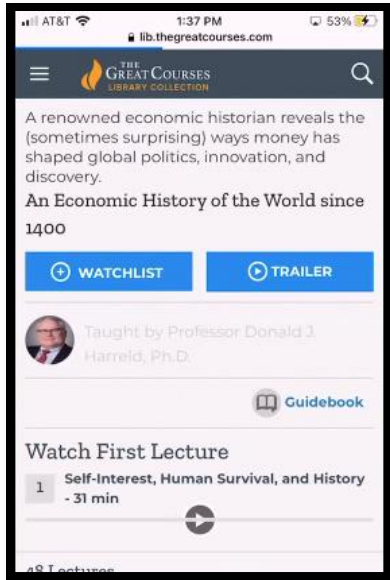




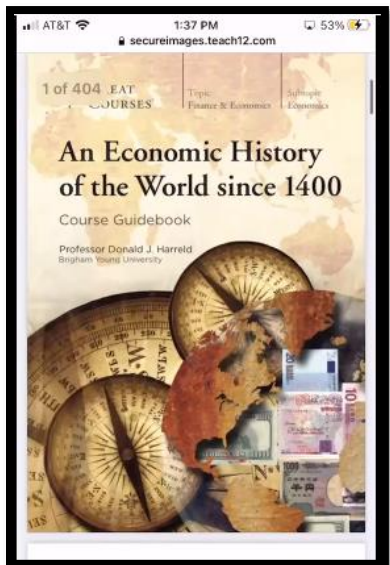
Like Method Test Prep, you will be offered a 7-day pass.



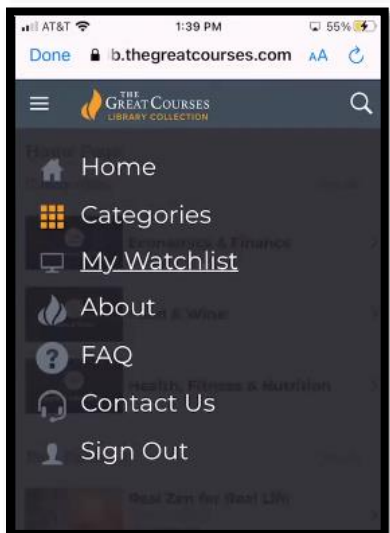
Use the keyword search or browse the categories to find courses that interest you.



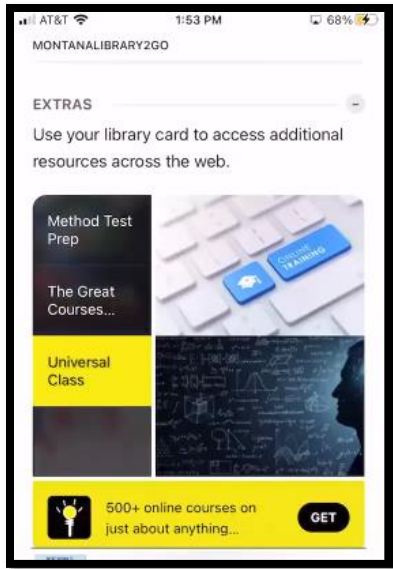
On the introductory page for each course you can add the course to your watchlist, view a brief trailer, download the course guidebook, and start the video for the first lecture.



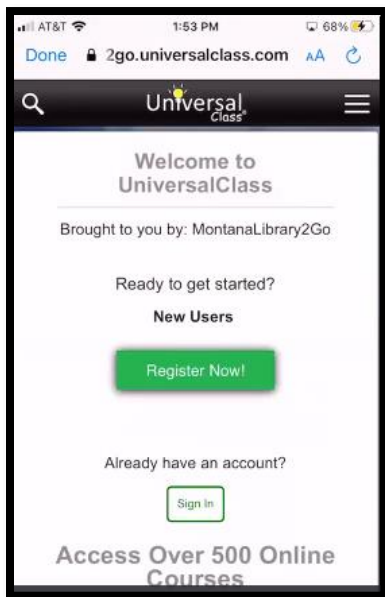
The guidebook will open in PDF format in a separate browser window and can be downloaded to your device.



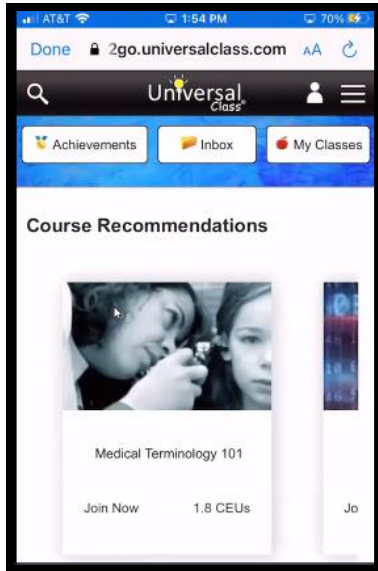
The pancake menu in the upper left corner gives you options to enter a keyword search via the magnifying glass icon, browse course categories, review your saved videos under “My Watchlist,” and find FAQ and contact information to help if you have problems using the service.



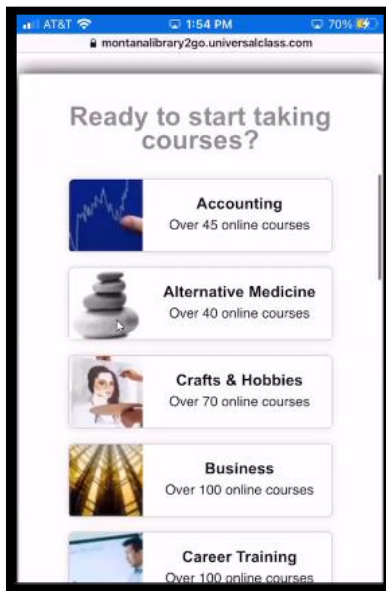
Finally, let's take a look at Universal Class. Again, tapping or clicking on this link will take you out to a separate browser window, where you can log in for a 7-day pass.



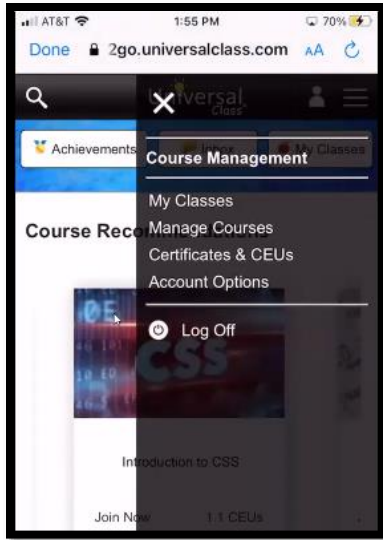
Choose "Register Now!" if this is your first time logging in as a MontanaLibrary2Go user.



On the home page you can review your progress and current classes, access your account information using the person icon in the upper right, use the keyword search in the upper left, and browse course offerings.



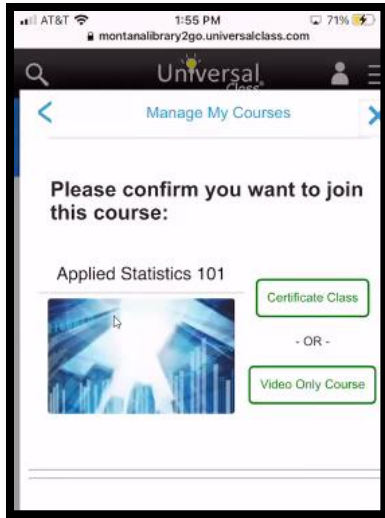
Tap on the magnifying glass icon in the upper left to open a screen where you can search or browse for classes.



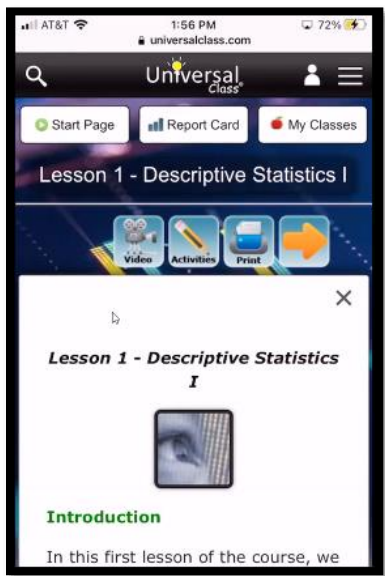
The pancake menu in the upper right also provides access to your class list, course management and account options, and certificate/course credit information.



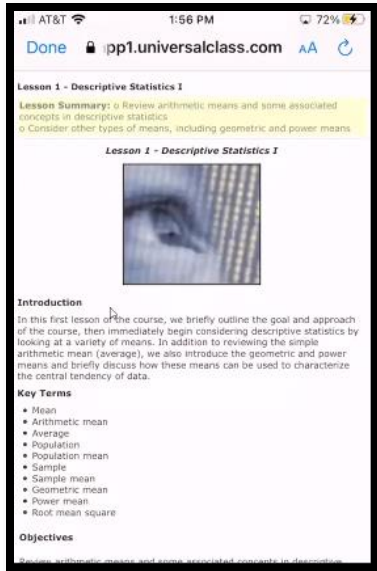
The introduction page for each class outlines the number of lessons, exams and credits (if applicable), and time commitment, as well as an overview of what to expect from the class.



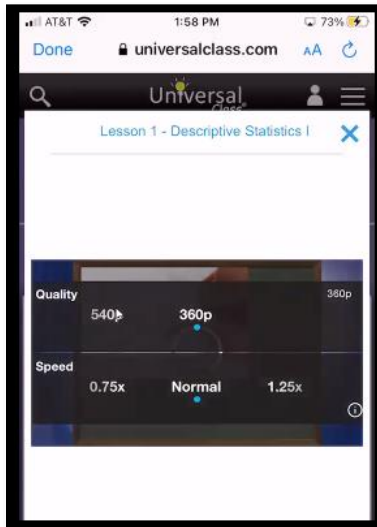
You can take a class for credit (which involves taking the exams) or chose "Video Only Course" for personal enjoyment.



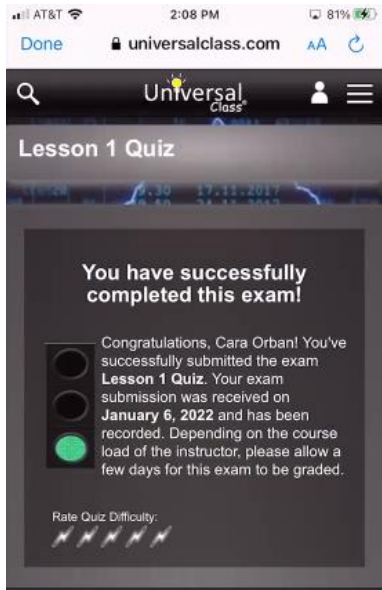
Within each lesson, you will find buttons linking to the lesson video and related activities, as well as an option to print the transcript. If you have already completed subsequent lessons, you can use the arrow button to skip ahead, but you must complete a lesson before you are allowed to advance.



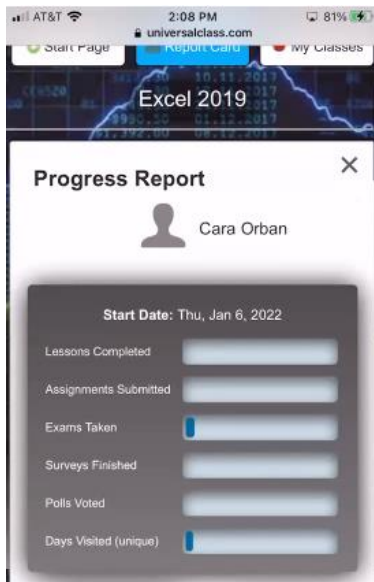
The “Print” option will open the transcript in a separate browser window.



Video settings can be adjusted for streaming quality and speed. Choose a lower quality number if your internet bandwidth is making it difficult to stream at a higher quality. Choose a lower speed number to play the video more slowly, or a higher number to increase the pace.

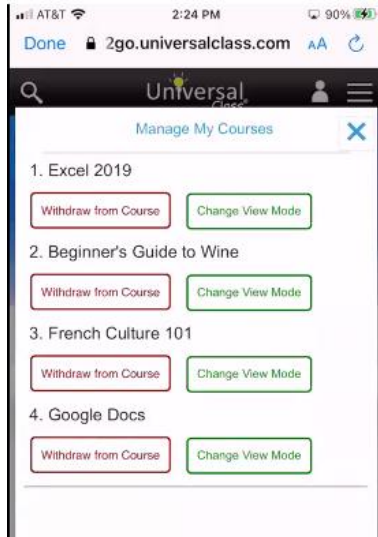


Exams taken for credit will be reviewed by a Universal Class instructor.



You can review your progress by selecting the "Report Card" button at the top of the home screen.





You can make changes to your class choices (credit or no credit) or withdraw from a course under “Manage Courses” in the pancake menu in the upper right corner.

When you are done using any of these extra services, simply tap or click “Done” in the upper left corner of your screen and you will be redirected back to the Libby app.
