

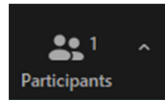

# Zooming like a pro!

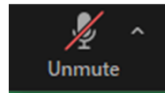
- Rename Yourself

  - Include your name, library, and role



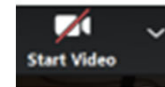
- Audio

- If you do not have a microphone, you can call in on a phone.



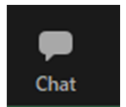
- Video

- We love seeing your smiling faces, but if you prefer to, you can turn video off by clicking “Stop Video” in the lower left-hand corner of the Zoom screen.



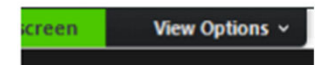
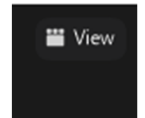
- Chat

- Click the “Chat” icon to add your comments or questions.



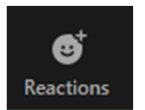
- View Options

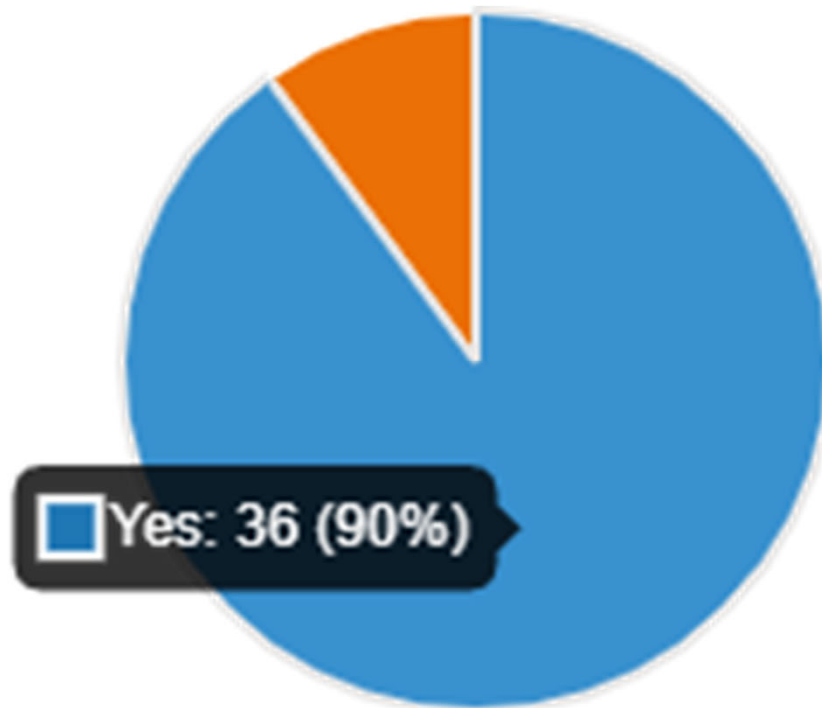

# Recommendation: Voluntary Trustee Track

# Recommendation: Library Administration Track

Total Required Credits	Library Administration Category	Electives
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Initial Certification: 60 continuing education credits earned in a 4-year period</li><li>• Renewal – 60 elective credits in any category earned in a 4-year period</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Initial Certification: Minimum of 30 credits</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Initial Certification: 30 additional credits in any category</li><li>• Renewal: 60 elective credits</li></ul>

# Draft Task Force Recommendations

In general, the Task Force recommends

- Adopting fewer, clearer, measurable, and actionable program goals;
- Adjusting the Library Administration Track to allow simplification and flexibility;
- Maintaining the Voluntary Trustee Track Requirements as is;
- Adjusting the Voluntary Staff Track requirements to allow simplification and flexibility;
- Addressing user experience with ASPeN to eliminate barriers to tracking continuing education credits;
- Providing lists of recommended courses for each certification track;
- Developing an accessible and consistent plan to promote Continuing Education and Certification Program and,
- Planning implementation for an effective date of July 1, 2024.
