Improving Each Year

- Summer Reading = unique opportunity for experimentation and improvement!

Collaborative Summer Library Program (CSLP)

- Collaborative Summer Library Program (CSLP)
 - ♦ Montana is a member of the CSLP consortium
 - Theme, slogan, professional artwork, planning manual, social media toolkit, PSAs, and MORE!
 - ♦ Free for any Montana public library to use
- Manual and access code is available starting in October each year, emailed directly to
 library directors
- ♦ Highly recommend exploring the website, to see what other resources are available

Summer Reading Trunk

- Partnership with MSL, MOR, and other related organizations, depending on the theme!
- ♦ Three or four activities with required materials, plus an activity guide
- Suboxing Webinar, usually in April or May, describing all trunk contents, and how to facilitate/adapt each activity
- ♦ Libraries can borrow the trunk to use for Summer Reading!

Town Pump "Keep Kids Reading" Grant

- Grant program for public libraries to help support summer reading programs
 \$1000 available
- ♦ Started in 2021, will hopefully continue in the future
- Other grants around the state may also be available!

Monthly MSL Webinars

- Summer Reading Brainstorm webinars once a month, starting in January
