The Finance Committee of the State Library Commission recommends adoption of the fiscal year 24 budget as proposed.

## HB 2 Adjustments:

- MSL's Hot Spot program was funded on a one time only basis from the coal severance fund at \$400,000 per year. Reporting requirements to the interim budget committee were added in the section E companion bill.
- Overall rent appropriation was decreased by \$128,000 due to the decreased cost in the off-campus lease.
- \$1,722 in general fund appropriation was added to cover costs associated with the new State Management Training Center.
- Federal appropriation was increased each year to match actual Institute of Museum and Library Services grant awards.
- One time only monies were appropriated from the Land Information account to fund the Real Time Network until the program is finalized.

## NAC Recommendations:

- Includes an increase in Federation payments from \$225,000 to \$249,000.
- Increase Montana History portal digitization from \$6,000 to \$36,000.
- Increase courier program funding from \$15,000 to \$65,000.

## Other items of interest:

- HB13 increases state employee pay by 4% or \$1.50, whichever is higher
- HB314 increases commission per diem to \$100 per day adds \$2,100 in general fund to MSL
- HB 91 continued state aid payments and extended them to tribal libraries. The per capita amount was also increased from \$0.40 to \$0.50.
- A proprietary fund and two permanent FTE were approved for the ongoing support of MSL's Real Time Network in HB60
- HB 132 removed funding for MSL's audit and appropriated those dollars to the Legislative Audit Division
