## Federation Study Recommendations

- Commission discussion and further action
  - Commission recognizes the importance of federation funds for libraries
  - Commission recognizes the value of support, training, and networking for trustees and librarians
  - Commission finds the structure of federations cumbersome
  - Commission directed staff to continue to study the structure of federations
  - During the December Commission meeting, staff will work with the Commission to create a new charge for the Federation Study Task Force.

## Change in Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM)

- Public library standards degree requirement; budget growth requirement; define hardship; define deferral process;
- State aid amend formula to include tribal college libraries

- Timeline:
  - July 2023
    - Task force sat and initial charge given
  - July through September
    - Research, discussion, recommendations review by library community
  - October 2023
    - Draft ARMs to Commission
  - November 2023
    - Public comment period, pending Commission action
  - December 2023
    - Commission adopts final ARMs

## Updates from the Network Advisory Council


 NAC met on August 8 to create the FY24 Library Development plan

#### Key priorities

- Position libraries to take advantage of federal funds to improve/increase Internet access and speed
- Assist libraries with building relationships with local governments
- Improve, provide access and training on foundational library skills
- Alter the Core Services Committee model to a conversation model where people are invited to share their ideas and thoughts about core library services

## **Broadband Funding**

- There is a significant amount of federal funding available for community anchor institutions – which includes libraries.
- The State Library Commission approved funding to contract with a consultant to help libraries create digital equity plans.
