Dear Sissy,

We have received your April 15, 2026 email and correspondence to me and Commissioner Kris Goss, members of the Montana State Library Commission, related to the Chouteau County Library. While we sincerely appreciate your input and take your concerns seriously, the State Library Commission does not investigate complaints against local libraries such as yours. Montana Code Annotated (MCA) § 22-1-103 outlines the duties of the Commission and does not give the Commission the authority to adjudicate alleged violations by local library trustees or employees of code of conduct and ethical standards. Under Montana law, those matters are addressed by the local library's Board of Trustees and the county attorney.

The State Library Commission remains committed to supporting all Montana libraries in achieving excellence through our advisory and standards programs. Thank you for your commitment to your community's library services.
