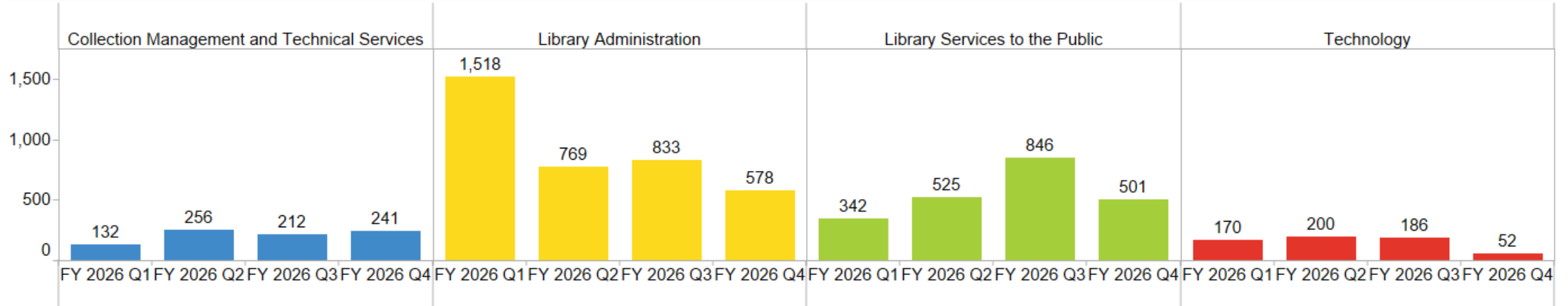

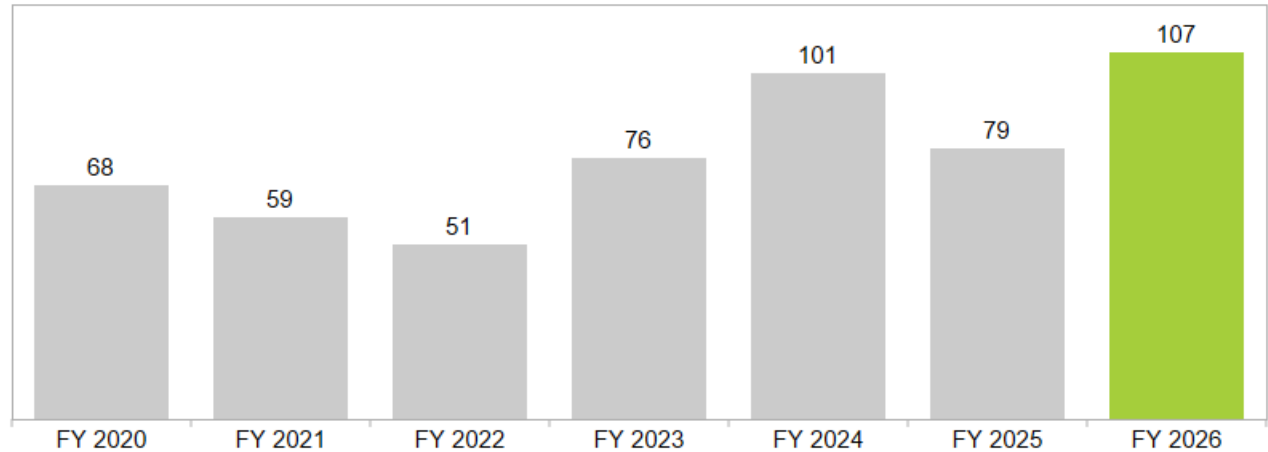
FY 2026 Credits Claimed by Category

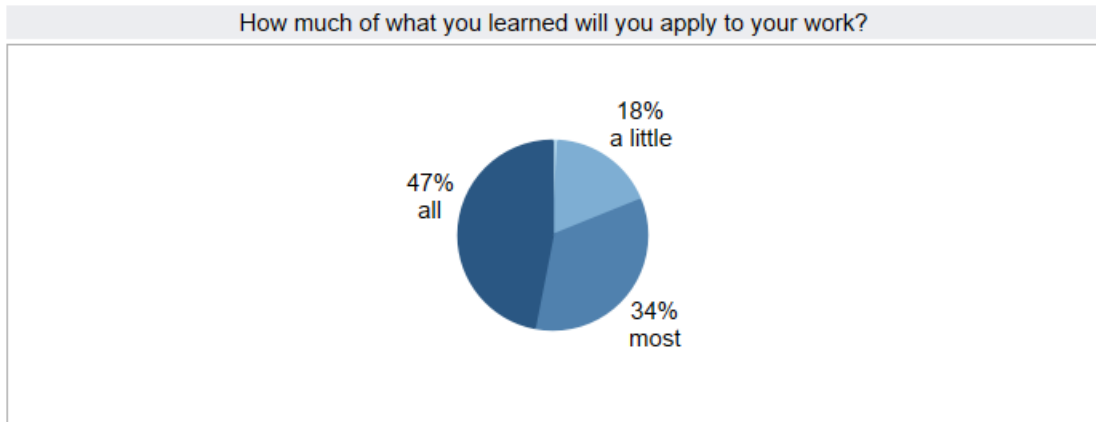
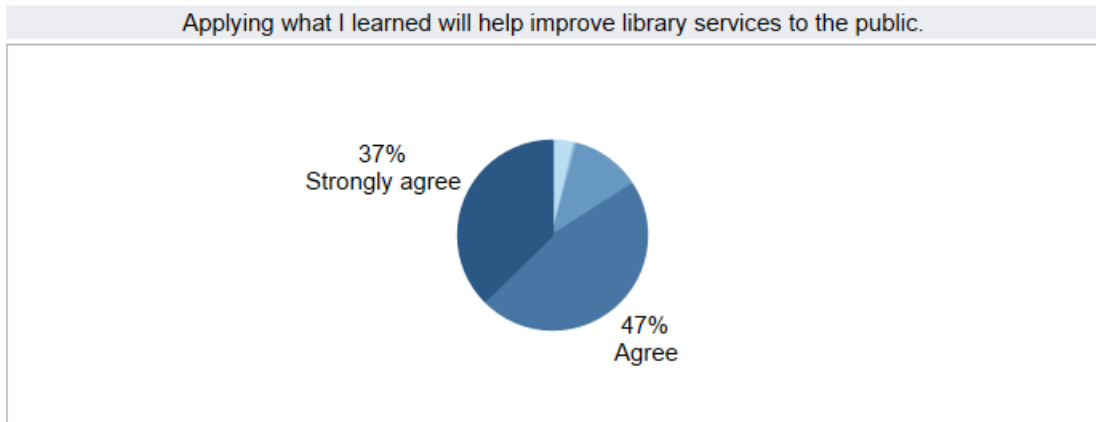

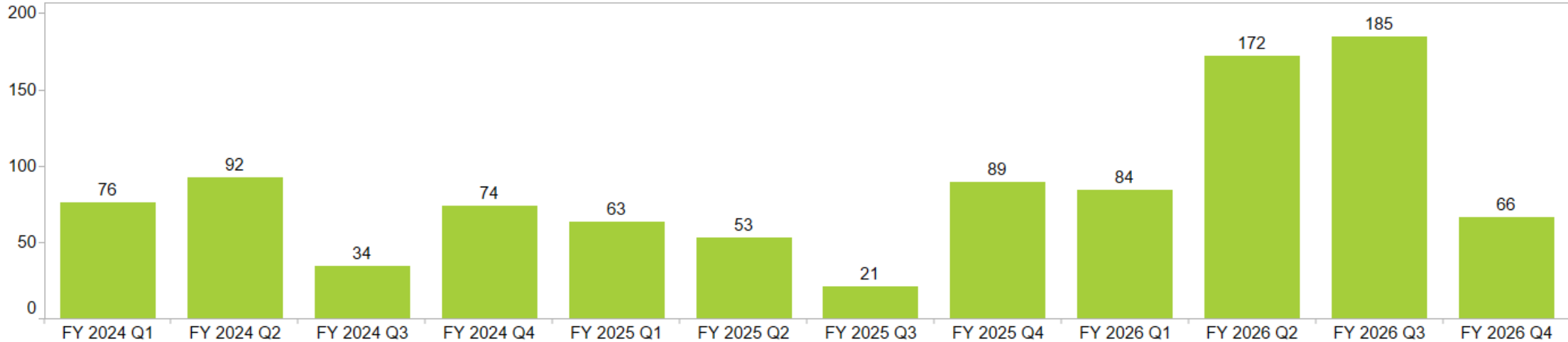
Certificates issued, excluding initial certificates earned by completing a Master of Library Science (MLS) degree and OPI renewal units.

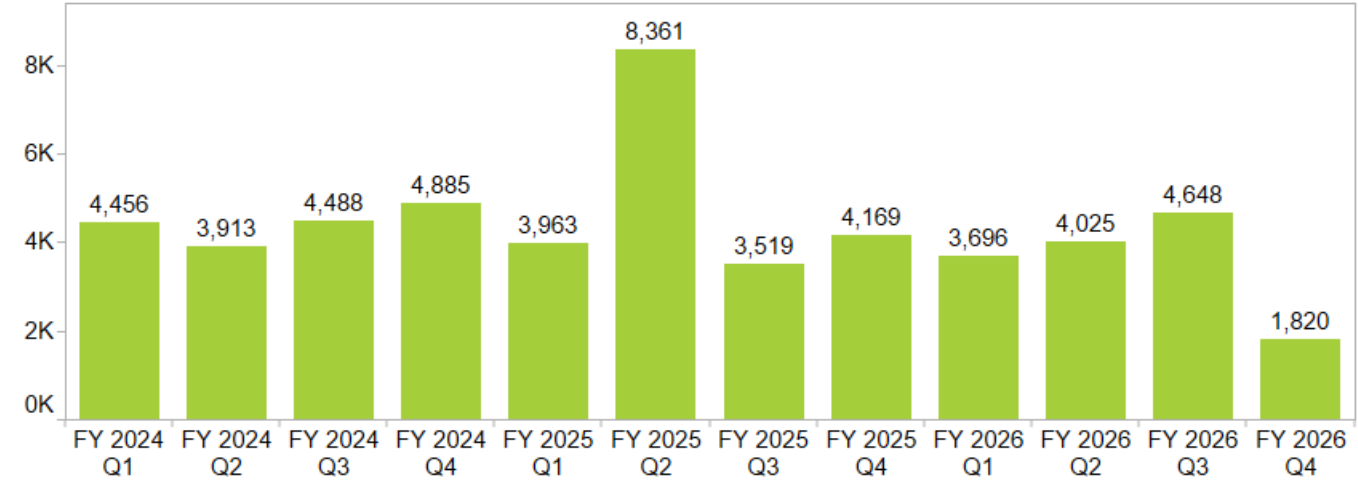

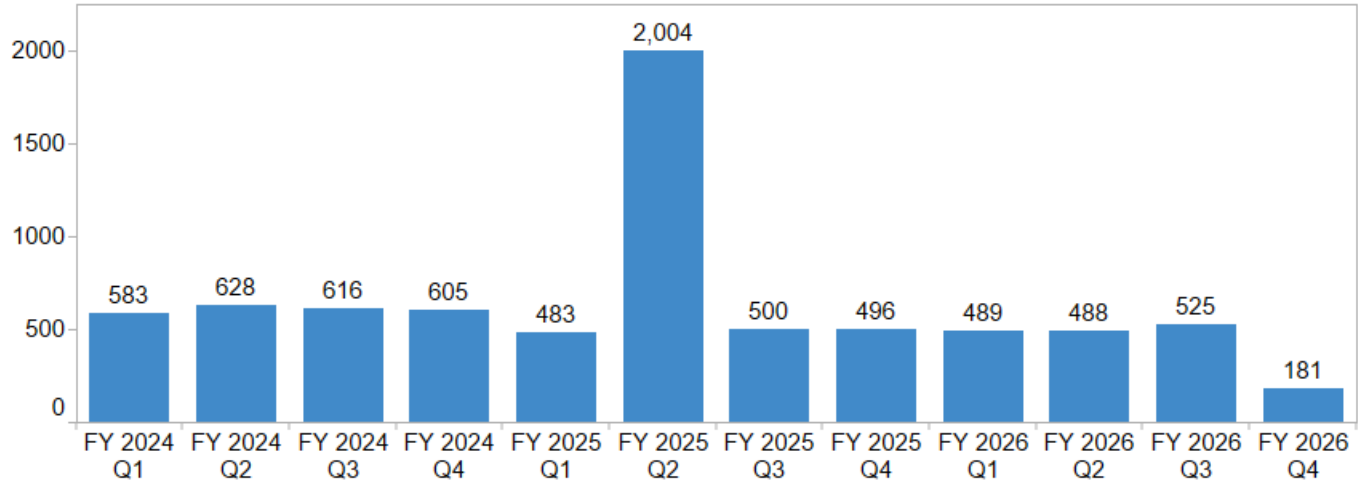

Total Watch Time in Hours

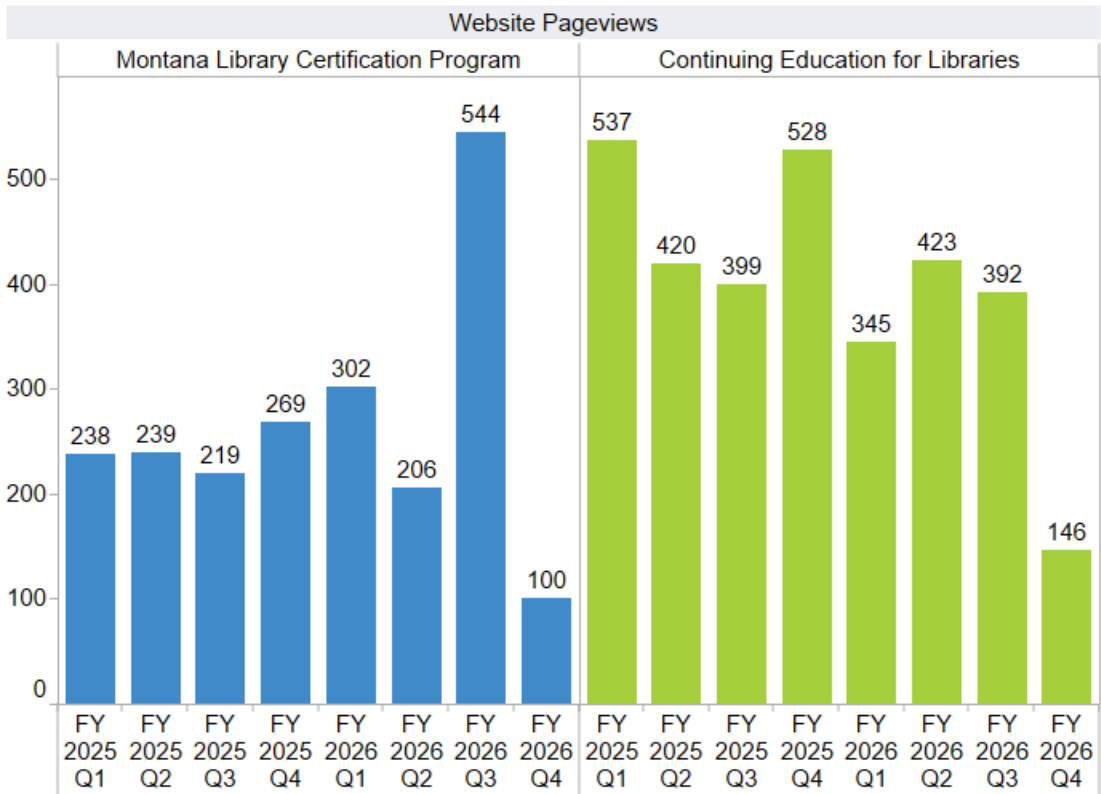
